We also took part in the Werrington carnival, which I'm sure is a first for the club and towards the end of the season a few of the youngsters had a go at racing including grass track, mountain biking and cyclo cross.

However last year they were not allowed to join our club, so we have now changed the club rules (at the A.G.M.) to actively encourage members of all ages.

Birgit Scott now holds the position

of club safeguarding officer. We are just about to make our plans for the coming year, so would like to take this opportunity to say that if any of you would like to get involved in any way then your help would be greatly appreciated.

Also we are going to have to spend quite a bit of money while we are setting this up particularly over the first couple of years so if any of you have access to funding or are aware of any we could be eligible for then please contact us with details.

More importantly than all of this if you know any youngsters who might be interested in coming along then please help us to spread the word and help swell the ranks.
