This year's club champion was Simon Pitchford who proved that by scoring consistently well throughout the year he was always going to be hard to beat.

The best young rider award went to George Smee, so his becomes the latest name on

the Holmes merit cup.

The best first year rider was so close the committee actually awarded it jointly to Luke Bloye & Sam Widdess for their excellent efforts and enthusiasm this year.

The annual hill climb award went to Simon Jacklin.

These awards also show the increase in numbers of younger members at the club, long may this continue.

To round off the occasion Dean Downing accompanied the riders on the club run the following morning, attracting plenty of attention in his Rapha team kit from other cycling groups as they went on their way to the Windmill tearoom at Wymondham.

By the way, the Committee decided just to hold over the Navigation Rally so I will put it on the calendar sometime next Summer, when, hopefully, it won't be a washout again.

A definite highpoint for me was being awarded the Elsie Airey Trophy for getting the club runs up and running again: it was a

complete surprise and I would like to thank whoever nominated me for that; it really is much appreciated.

Well, there are a few runs left on this year's calendar, and I haven't yet done the calendar for the first quarter of next year, but I have pencilled in the following for the 5 Sundays in January, all between 40 and 50 miles and not too difficult:

24 Jan: New Lodge Farm Cafe between Bulwick & Laxton – via Kings Cliffe and Blatherwycke, returning via Deenethorpe, Benefield, Glapthorn and Nassington

31st Jan: Uppingham Beans Cafe – via Stamford, Edith Weston, Wing and returning via Seaton, Harringworth, Laxton, Blatherwycke, Kings Cliffe and Wansford.

Later on next year I plan to include the usual variety of distances, directions, terrain and some new tea stops; maybe a couple of Youth

The Annual Mildenhall Cycle Rally

Each August bank holiday weekend there is an excellent event with something for everybody from the small fenland town of Mildenhall. This event has been run for over twenty years now so the organisers are getting used to providing a wide range of activities to suit the large number that always attend. Despite this being a well-established event they always try to keep it interesting by making a few changes each year. This year saw the return of roller racing in the main hall on the Saturday evening, to a packed audience all cheering

for their favourites. The whole weekend is centred around a school, with the playing fields providing a camping field and a separate field reserved for the main attraction of grass track racing over the three days. We normally have a few of our riders involved in the racing to give us someone to cheer for. This takes place around a small grass oval usually lined with many supporters in their deckchairs or browsing some of the many trade stands.

On the Saturday there are also organised Audax rides, although most of the twenty or so riders from Fenland Clarion usually arrange their own rides around the pleasant Suffolk lanes. Saturday evening is when the Clarion usually has their barbeque with around thirty there this year (2009).

As well as the track racing there are a variety of children's races both cycling and running with the emphasis on fun. There are also duathlon events for both adults and children with some very keen and often very able smaller children popular with the spectators. On Monday there is free admission into the local swimming pool for a change from cycling. Hopefully this has given a few of you an idea of the range of events on offer at this popular weekend, so why not consider joining the twenty or more of your Clarion friends this year and help make it even better.
