

National Clarion Third Party Insurance.

It is in the interests of anybody who has identifiable wealth (house, car etc) to insure themselves for public liability claims. No one is infallible and it is possible to do serious damage on a bicycle in a momentary lapse of concentration. Third party insurance ensures a consequent claim is met in part at least by the insurer and does not have to be covered by a realisation of personal assets.

The National Clarion as a result of affiliation to the CTC are now able to offer third party insurance (up to £10m) when riding a bicycle for a fee of £12.00 annually (between 6 and 12 months initially) or £8.00 for half a year or less. The full premium is due annually on the 1st October but anyone joining after the 1st April will pay £8.00 and this will run until the annual premium due date.

If you wish to take advantage of this facility you should post your premium to the National Treasurer along with the following completed form to the above address. Your cheque should be made payable to National Clarion Cycling Club.

NB your affiliation is not valid until received by CTC so please ensure that you send to the National Treasurer at the above address 28 days before the due date.
